STUDENTS' SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT

INTRODUCTION

The only ever centre of higher education in the greater Hajo area, Suren Das College, was established on 29th August, 1979. Beginning with a few students, it was formally known as Hajo Anchalik College, and was housed in the premises of Hajo S.B.S.K.R. Higher Secondary School, Hajo.

The college is the outcome of the dream and untiring efforts of a group of benevolent persons and educationalists of Hajo area. Not only that, the mass participation to the course can be seen in the immense contribution made by various organizations to the college. Organizations such as the No.1 Hajo Gaon Panchayat SamabaySamiti have been making substantial contributions towards the growth and development of the college ever since its inception. The two storied science building of the college is a kind science building of the college is a kind donation of this SamabaySamiti.

The family of Late Suren Das (20th February, 1925 – 18th March, 1982) a noble man of philanthropic outlook donated the existing two-storied Arts building of the college on the land relinquished in favour of the college by the DhoparguriSatra authority. As a mark of respect to their contributions and in order to commemorate Late Suren Das, the Governing Body of the college decided to rename the college as Suren Das College in 1985. The college came under deficit grants-in-aid system w.e.f. 01-01-1987 and has been permanently affiliated to Gauhati University w.e.f. 1994 and is registered under 2(f) and 12(b) of the UGC Act, 1956 w.e.f. 1994-95.

Suren Das College is located at an ideal tranquil site in front of the famous Dhoparguri Satra established by the great Vaishnava saint Sri Madhabdeva and it is sprawling over more than 15 Bighas of land. The place itself has immense historical and socio-anthropological importance. People from all walks of life come to Hajo, to visit the famous pancha-tirtha namely Hayagriba Madhab temple, Kedareswar Temple, Kamaleswar temple, Kameswar temple and Ganesh temple. The coexistence of the panchatirthas and the Poamecca Shrine fosters brotherhood and creates amity in the society.

Conveniently, the college is located on the Barpeta-Daulasal-Guwahati and Hajo-Nalbari road and is about 25 k.ms from Jalukbari, Guwahati. Easy access

of communication to different places provides a congenial atmosphere for diligent academic pursuit.

Students' Satisfaction Survey

A survey study was done by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell to understand the satisfaction of the students on the education system and the infrastructure facilities of the college. The students were selected randomly.

Title: Students Satisfaction on the College Education System and Infrastructure Facilities.

Objectives:

The main objectives of the study-

- 1. To study the students satisfaction on Education system of the college.
- 2. To study the students satisfaction on infrastructure facilities offered by the college.

Methodology:

The investigation followed the descriptive survey method for the present study. Sample population is consisted with 200 students who were randomly selected.

Tools:

A set of questionnaire with 33 questions were used as tools for the study. Out of 33, eighteen questions represented education system and fifteen questions were used to collect the opinion of the students for infrastructure facilities of the college.

Area of the study:

The college campus was used as the area of the study and the students of the college were selected randomly as the main population of the study.

Sample of the study:

Total 200 students were selected randomly as the sample of the study

Analysis and interpretation of the data:

Keeping in view the objectives of the study, the analysis of the data has been made under two categories. They are positive and negative response of the students. Head wise students satisfaction and dissatisfaction percentage is shown bellow in the Table 1.1.

According to the study done by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell total number of response in head of college education system are 3600.Out of 3600, 3119 or 86.37% were positive response and 481 or 13.37% were negative response. Thus we can explain that 86.63% students are satisfied by the education system of the college. Again 3000 response were collected sample on the infrastructure facilities of the college. Out of 3000response 2389 or 79.63% are the positive response and 611 or 20.37% are the negative response.

Findings of the study:

Students satisfaction percentage is higher than the dissatisfaction percentage on the college education system and infrastructure facilities.

Discussion of the study:

The present study shows that the opinion of the students or respondant are highly positive towards education system of the college and rules of the college. But negative responses are also found in the study. There are some assumed causes for dissatisfaction of the respondent. Which are as follows-

a) For Academic system:

- There are insufficient teachers in the college.
- According to the students ICT based education is not imparted by all the teachers.

- The respondent students express their dissatisfaction with the guidance and counselling centre of the college.
- b) For infrastructure facilities:
 - The respondent students express their negative response on toilet system of the college.
 - They are dissatisfied by the canteen facility and the cleanliness of the classrooms.

Action to be taken:

- More ICT based class roomsare required.
- Guidence and counselling cell which is already planning their roles in the college. Awareness regarding the counselling and active role of the cell is necessary.
- Vacant posts needs to be filled upm at the earliest.
- Toilet facilities tobe improved in term of number and hygiene.
- Class rooms should bemore neat and should have lively physical environment.

The dissatisfaction of the students have been placed before the college authority for necessary action.
