COLLEGE PROFILE

(NAAC Accredited: 2nd cycle, “B” Grade, IIC rating: 2 star, ARIIA status: Performer; NIRF: Participated)

The only nerve centre of higher education in the greater Hajo area, Suren Das College, was established on 29th August, 1979. Beginning with only a few students, it was formerly known as Hajo Anchalik College, and was housed in the premises of Hajo S.B.S.K.R. Higher Secondary School, Hajo.

The college is the outcome of the dream and untiring efforts of a group of benevolent persons and educationists of Hajo area. Not only that, the mass participation to the cause can be seen in the immense contribution made by various organizations to the college. Organisations such as the No.1 Hajo Gaon Panchayat Samabay Samiti have been making substantial contributions towards the growth and development of the college ever since its inception. The two storied science building of the college is a kind donation of this Samabay Samiti.

The family of Late Suren Das (20 Feb, 1925-18 March, 1982), a noble man of philanthropic outlook, donated the existing two-storied Arts building of the college on the land relinquished in favour of the college by the Dhoparguri Satra authority. As a mark of respect to their contributions, and in order to commemorate Late Suren Das, the Governing Body of the College decided to rename the college as Suren Das College in 1985. The College came under deficit grants-in-aid system w.e.f. 01-01-1987 and has been permanently affiliated to Gauhati University w.e.f. 1994 and is registered under 2(F) and 12(B) of the UGC Act 1956 w.e.f. 1994-95

LOCATION

Suren Das College is located at an ideal tranquil site in front of the famous Dhoparguri Satra established by the great Vaishnava Saint Sri Sri Madhabdeva and it is sprawling over more than 15 Bighas of land. The place itself has immense historical and socio-anthropological importance. People from all walks of life come to Hajo to visit the famous Pancha-tirthas namely Hayagriba Madhaba temple, Kedareshwara temple, Kamaleswara temple, Kameswara temple and Ganesh temple. The coexistence of the Panchatirthas and the Poa mecca shrine fosters brotherhood and creates amity in the society.

Conveniently, the college is located on the Barpeta-Daulasal-Guwahati and Hajo-Nalbari road and is about 25 kms from Jalukbari, Guwahati. Easy access of communication to different places provides a congenial atmosphere for diligent academic pursuit.

INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES OFFERED

Suren Das College offers almost all the required facilities of an institution of Higher Education.

- 1. Admission: Only online form fill-up facility is available for admission.**
- 2. College administration:** The administrative office is located in the science building. It is fully digitalized and automated with office management software. Activities like admission and registration of students, maintenance of accounts etc. are done digitally.
- 3. Classrooms and laboratories:** Adequate number of classrooms with spacious area are available. A big two storied building with an area of 15,000 sq. ft. (7500 sq. ft. Ground floor & 7500 sq. ft. 1st floor) has been donated by Hajo No.1 *Samabay Samiti*. Two well equipped laboratories with sufficient spaces for the Dept.of Geography and Education are there to cater to the needs of the students. Four well equipped laboratories for Science Stream are also available and expansion of which are to be made shortly for B.Sc. Course. New RCC Block classrooms construction funded by RUSA has already been completed and is now used for M.A. (Pol. Science) classes.
- 4. College Library:** The College Library is a two storied building occupying a floor area of more than 4000 sq. ft. There is a spacious reading room to accommodate at least 150 students at a time for self-study. The library has around 20,300 books, 15 magazines and periodicals, more than 12 national and regional dailies. It has internet facility with e-journals (50 databases of national & international journal), 90,000 e – books as well as photocopy facility. It follows open access system and enjoys library Automation with Soul

(Network Version), library management software developed by INFLIBNET (Information and library Network Centre Ahmedabad). Extension of Library has been completed by RUSA fund. Our library has obtained institutional membership with National Digital Library (NDL). The best Reader Award is conferred to students annually from amongst the regular users of the Library

5. **Book Bank:** The college has introduced a Book Bank in the Library for helping the deserving students with Text Books and Reference Book.
6. **Departmental Library:** Apart from the college Library, the students can also use the books of the departmental libraries.
7. **Hostel:** The College has a Girls' Hostel that can accommodate more than 100 boarders. Hostel seats will be offered only to unmarried girl students.
8. **Seminar Hall:** The Seminar Hall can accommodate approximately 160 persons. It is furnished with latest equipment's like short throw projector, overhead projector, ITC Podium, ITC portable PA system etc. These are also used as teaching aids.
9. **Computer Laboratory :** A fully AC Computer Lab consisting of around 30 branded computers loaded with windows latest version is also available in the college. All computers are based on Pentium IV and Dual Core Technology. The Computers are connected to LAN through a central server.
10. **Language Lab :** The College has a well-equipped Language Lab. It is an effective electronic audio visual aid for acquiring proficiency in any language through the software of Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing. (LSRW).
11. **Multi- GYM :** The multi-gym is situated on the 2nd floor of Science Building. Students, teachers and even the outsiders can avail this facility on payment of nominal fee. It will be shifted soon to the newly constructed Indoor Stadium which is funded by the UGC.
12. **Information & Career Guidance Cum Placement Cell:** This cell endeavours to make students aware of employment opportunities and competitive examinations organised by different Govt. & Non Govt. agencies. The cell operates under the guidance of an experienced and resourceful teacher.
13. **Auditorium:** A sophisticated auditorium fully acoustic with a capacity to accommodate approximately 500 persons, fitted with latest equipments Sound system, large dice etc.
14. **College Office:** College Office is situated in the administrative part of the Science Building in the ground floor. The College office is provided with Academic DCL, a locally developed office management software that is installed to automate all the functions and activities of the office. Activities like Admission, Registration of Students, Accounts, Salary Statement etc. are being computerized.
15. **Common Room for students:** The Boys' & Girls' Common Rooms are provided with adequate facilities.
16. **Uninterrupted Electric Supply:** The College has provided two Generator Sets with 10KVA & 30KVA capacities to provide uninterrupted power supply. Process is on to provide electricity through Solar Energy tapping device.
17. **Canteen:** The College Canteen remains open during class hours that provide hygienic food at nominal rate. There is a Canteen Committee to look after its management. The canteen is renovated by RUSA fund.
18. **Departmental Room for Teachers:** Departmental Room of teachers is provided with adequate facilities like library, Desktop PC with Internet connection and open accessibility of e-resources.
19. **Teachers' Common Room**
20. **Smart Classes:** We have set up two smart classrooms and three ICT classrooms to provide benefits of modern and digital modes of teaching to the students.
21. **Drinking Water:** Purified drinking water is available for all in the college campus.
22. **Wi-Fi facility:** The college has 10 mbps high speed Wi-Fi with lease line facility.
23. **Indoor sports stadium:** Adjacent to the Girls' Hostel, the Indoor sports stadium has been constructed with the fund by the UGC under 12th Plan period. Well equipped with modern sports facilities, it can accommodate many indoor games at a time.
24. **Basketball court:** A basketball court is constructed by RUSA fund.
25. **Feedback & Attendance:** Feedback as well as attendance of students will be maintained through online process from the 2019-20 session.
26. **Rain water harvesting unit:** Our college has a rainwater harvesting unit for proper utilization of rainwater.
27. **Vermicomposting unit :** A vermicompost unit is constructed to utilize the bio-degradable wastes.
28. **Facilities for PWD :** Our college has ramps, wheel chair, walking stick, separate toilet etc. in all buildings for differently able students.
29. **Online UPS :** Our college has Online UPS facilities.
30. **Solar Lights :** Our college has Solar light lamp in various place of college campus.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

1. Admission in the college is made strictly in order of merit and is governed as per guidelines of AHSEC/Gauhati University
2. No Online application form will be accepted after the last date as notified and all incomplete applications will be stand automatically rejected.
3. Seats will be reserved for SC/ST/OBC Category as per Govt. reservation rule. The college follows the Reservation policy of the Government and the segregation of seats as per quota are: SC: 7%, ST (Hills): 5%, ST (Plains): 10%, OBC/MOBC: 15%, Physically Disabled: 3%, Extra Curricular Activities: 2%, Freedom Fighter: 2%
4. **A student has to upload the following documents at the time of online form submission:**
 - i. Original Mark sheet of last examination passed.
 - ii. Original Pass Certificate from issued by the AHSEC/GU or the head of the Institution last attended.
 - iii. A Gap Certificate stating reasons is to be produced by the student who had passed the qualifying examination earlier. (If Applicable)
 - iv. Migration / Transfer Certificate as the case may be. (If Applicable)
 - v. Candidates seeking admission under the mentioned categories in clause-3 have to produce Certificate from Govt. authority.
 - vi. Certificate of Proficiency in Co-curricular and Extra Curricular activities as the case may be.
 - vii. Proof of age (HSLC Admit Card)
 - viii. Caste Certificate. (If Applicable)
 - ix. Front Page of Bank Passbook.
 - x. Valid mobile no and E-mail ID which is not changeable upto completion of the course.
5. Admission to the college hostel (Girls only) will be held immediately after the college admission for which separate application in prescribed form is to be submitted.

A student who has passed Bachelor of Arts with Political Science as Honours Course from any recognized University.

Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (PGDCA)

A student who has passed the Degree Examination from any recognized University.

Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA)

A student who has passed Higher Secondary Examination in Arts/Science/Commerce or any other equivalent examination.

B. Voc. 1st Semester (Three Year Degree Course)

For admission in MLT, a student must have passed H.S. in Science Stream.

For admission in DDT and THM, a student who has passed Higher Secondary Examination in Arts/Science/Commerce or any other equivalent examination.

B. TDC in (Arts) as per Under Graduate Choice Based Credit System (UGCBCS)

The CBCS provides an opportunity for the students to choose courses from the prescribed courses comprising core, elective or skill based courses. As per decision of GU, CBCS is going to be introduced in TDC (BA) Course from 2019-20 Academic Session and B. Sc. From 2020-21 academic session as per GU guidelines. The Undergraduate course has been termed as Honours course and Regular Course. In line with the UGC's guidelines, the courses are categorized as Core courses, elective courses and Ability Enhancement courses.

1. **Core course is compulsory both for Honours and Regular program.**
2. **Elective course can be chosen from the subjects available in the college.**
It is of 3 types
 - a) Discipline specific elective (DSE)

CAREER ORIENTED PROGRAMMES AND VOCATIONAL COURSES

1. B. Voc. in MLT, DDT and THM

The Bachelor of Vocation (B. Voc.) is a new initiative of MHRD, Government of India, to align Higher education with the emerging needs of the economy through nurturing and improving skills and entrepreneurial abilities of the students. B. Voc. is a three year degree course and is equivalent to other degree courses like BA, B. Sc. and B.Com as per UGC notification.

Course Details & eligibility criteria:

1. **Medical Laboratory Technology:** Medical laboratory technology is a medical science course that deals with laboratory tests and analysis in a bid to finding the root cause to a problem and proffering corrective measures likewise. The total duration of the course is three years. However, students will have flexibilities in choosing the duration of the course. As per UGC guideline, students will get Certificate in MLT, Diploma in MLT, Advanced Diploma in MLT and B.Voc in MLT depending on the number of semester completed.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

DISCIPLINE

All Rules and Regulations for Higher Secondary and Degree courses are followed as per the guidelines of AHSEC/GU. A Committee, called Discipline committee, will go for maintaining the discipline of the college. Uses of Mobile phone & Tobacco of any form are strictly prohibited inside the college campus. Wearing of College Uniform is compulsory. Students should always bring their Identity Card. All are entrusted with the responsibility to keep the college campus clean, green and pollution-free. A strong Anti-ragging Committee is being constituted to check ragging, and anti-social menace.

ATTENDANCE

1. A student, including the Scholarship holders is not eligible to sit in the Examination as regular candidate unless his or her attendance found less than **75% in each subject**. 75% attendance is compulsory for appearing in sessional & end semester examination.
2. Attendance in the practical classes is compulsory.
3. A student abstaining from classes continuously for 25 days or more during the session without any valid ground shall forfeit his/her seat.

DRESS CODE

The College will provide sample of the uniform to all the students during the time of admission and hence they will be responsible for preparing it. Students must wear decent uniform: **Boys – Straight Regular fit Shirts and Trousers; Girls – Regular fit Trousers of Patiala** mode will be allowed. In winter, students are to wear Black colour sweater. Violation of the dress code is a punishable offence and hence they will not be allowed to attend classes.

ACTIVITIES

Students Union (SDCSU): Suren Das College Students' Union is the elected body of students' representatives for a year. Election is annually conducted according to the provision of the constitution of the college Students' Union and the Supreme Court verdict. The Students' Union organises Freshman social, College week, various festivals etc.

College Magazine: The college magazine is a common platform for the members of the family of the college. The magazine is annually published wherein the talent of the students as well as staff could be manifested.

NSS: The National Service Scheme Unit (NSS) works under an Advisory Body chaired by the Principal. The volunteers of NSS Unit are rendering commendable work by encouraging students to cherish dignity of labour and reverence for the composite Indian Culture.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC): The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been constituted as per the NAAC guidelines. It looks into the various activities of the college, both academic and administrative, in order to bring quality in all respect.

College Foundation Day: The College Foundation Day is celebrated on the 29th August every year. Students showing best performances in the final examinations and faculty members for their meritorious performances are felicitated in the function held on this foundation day. Special lectures are also organised on this auspicious day.

Women' Studies Cell: The Women Cell of the College conducts and arranges meetings, workshops, seminars etc for spreading awareness on issues allied to Women empowerment and gender justice.

Extension Education: The institution undertakes extension education, or outreach programmes in order to spread awareness among community people on issues like environment, education, social justice, deadly diseases like AIDS, Cancer etc. In pursuance of Govt. instructions we have already adopted Hajo Kaibartatola village along with Manikut High School, Hajo and R. B. K. Anchalik High School, Kalitakuchi.

Students' Aid Fund : The College has a Students' Aid Fund formed by the contribution of the students to help the poor but meritorious students of the college. The Fund also provides assistance to meet medical expenses of students when and where required.

Mentoring System: The College follows Mentoring system as part of Best Practice where students groups are formed having 25-30 students per group under the leadership of a teacher. The concerned teacher looks into the various problems both academic and personal faced by the individuals of the group and suggest to solve these problems in order to inculcate quality amongst the students.

Complaint & Suggestion Box: Suggestion from students/parents/guardians/well-wishers related to the development of the College are welcome and they may be dropped in the Suggestion Box placed at the administrative building.

Students' Feedback: Students of all classes are asked to provide their comments regarding teaching/learning/evaluation (teacher wise) through a online Feedback system which are analysed by the Feedback Committee. The Committee, subsequently takes appropriate steps for improving the quality of education.

Wall Magazine: Every department and cell of the college publishes Wall Magazine regularly. Students Participate and engage themselves in preparing and publishing these magazines.

Participation in Extra Curricular Activities: Students are encouraged to get themselves involved with different extracurricular activities of the college.

COLLEGE EXAMINATION

1. A) All Examinations (Test/Annual/Sessional) are conducted by centrally Examination Committee of the college. Details of these tests are available in the Academic Calendar cum Progress Records of students.
B) Departments monitor the academic performance of each and every student throughout the year.
2. Student's performance is monitored throughout the Semester by continuous assessment in the theory and practical paper based on the following :
Internal Evaluation Marks: 20% / 15%
External Evaluation Marks: 80% / 60%
3. Internal Evaluation is based on one Sessional examination, home assignments, Projects work seminars and library work in each Semester. (include all the parts)
4. External Evaluation is done through a final examination at the end on the Semester.
5. The Pass Mark in each theory paper is 30% and that in each practical paper is 40%
6. In each paper, students must secure pass marks in both the internal and the external evaluations separately.
7. A student who did not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
 - i) First Semester with the regular Third Semester examination.
 - ii) Second Semester with the regular Fourth Semester examination
 - iii) Third Semester with the regular Fifth Semester examination
 - iv) Fourth Semester with the regular Sixth Semester examination
8. A student may be allowed to "repeat" any one of the major theory papers in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd Semester.
9. No "repeat" shall be allowed in the 4th, 5th, and 6th Semester.
10. A student must pass all his/her Semester examinations, within six years from the date of admission to the 1st Semester course.
11. Since the Semester involve continuous assessment there would be no scope for a student to appear as a private/non-collegiate candidate in any subject.
12. For any matter not covered under this Regulation for Semester System, the existing University Rules and the Gauhati University Act 1949 (as amended till date) should be applicable.

Transfer Certificate: Students seeking transfer on a valid ground are to apply on plain paper to the office of the Principal with permission from the competent authority. A fee of Rs.200 will be charged for processing the transfer certificate. No transfer certificate will be issued after the last Unit Test if not informed prior to the examination.
