#### **Eye Check-up Camp**

The NSS Unit of Suren Das College in association with Sri Sankardev Nethralaya, Guwahati, organised a free eye check-up camp on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 for the people of Hajo area. Dr. Isha Agarwal, Ophthalmologist and a group of other 4 optometrist from Sri Sankardev Nethralaya attended the camp to serve the people. Dr. Hiranya Kumar Sarma, Principal, Suren Das College inaugurated the camp. Mr. Rajib Das, Programme officer, NSS Unit, Suren Das College explained the purpose of the camp. Altogether 215 OPD patients attended, out of which 52 Cataract patients of BPL category were detected. 22 cataract patients of the said category have already received the surgical treatment free of cost at Sri Sankardev Nethralaya, Guwahati.

#### **Essay Competition on the occasion of World Environment Day**

On the occasion of World Environment Day (5<sup>th</sup> June), the Extension Cell of Suren Das College organised an Essay Competition among the students of Class IX & X of RBK High School and Manikut High School, Hajo on the topic 'Natural Environment and our Responsibilities'. There were forty-nine (49) participants. The top six were awarded with books and certificates. The other participants also received participation certificate. Dr. Meena Kumari Devi, Coordinator of Extension Cell conducted the Prize distribution ceremony.

More than 60 participants of the village were benefited by the free health check-up programme and medicines with free of cost were also supplied to them.

### **Awareness programme on COVID-19 pandemic**

The Extension Cell in collaboration with IQAC of Suren Das College Hajo organized an awareness programme on COVID-19 pandemic on 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2020 among the local public. The faculties of the college were organized a campaign program in the local area and distributed various kinds of pamphlets related to information of corona virus for common public. Hand sanitizers were distributed as the precautionary measures to be taken to avoid its infection and spread and also encouraged people to wash their hands regularly, avoid gathering and to use mask.



### **Distribution of Food materials**

### **Survey at Fakirtola Village, Hajo**

The people were seen to be specially engaged in daily wage labour and small businesses and were severely affected by lockdowns imposed due to Covid-19 pandemic.



### **Extension Education Programme**

An Extension Education Programme was organised by the Geography department at Hajo Boys’ Senior Basic school on 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2021. The students of the dept. taught Social Studies in class VI & VII.

### **Field study on voter’s awareness**

The students of B.A. 1<sup>st</sup> Semester and B.A. 3<sup>rd</sup> Semester Honours along with M.A. 1<sup>st</sup> Semester students of Dept. of Political Science performed a “Pre-Election Field Study on Voter’s Awareness” in Four Gaon Panchayats of Hajo Anchalik Panchayat in the month of March, 2021. The level of political consciousness was seen to be significantly low among the rural residents of Hajo.



### **Training on Fruits and Vegetables Preservation**

A three-month long training programme on Fruits and Vegetables Preservation was conducted by the Women’s Studies Cell in collaboration with Jan Shikshan Sansthan, Kamrup, under the Ministry of Skill Development, Govt. of India. The course was inaugurated on 17<sup>th</sup> December, 2020. During the training programme, the students and

local women gained knowledge on the preparation of different jam, pickles, sweets, sauce etc. which helped them in upliftment of their economic condition.



### **Mask and hand sanitizer distribution camp**

On 24<sup>th</sup> April 2021, the NSS Unit organised a mask and hand sanitizer distribution camp in Kaibortotola (adopted village of Suren Das College) as a health awareness initiative keeping in view the impending threat of COVID-19. The programme was coordinated by Mr. Rajib Das, Program Officer of NSS cell and HoD, Department of Mathematics and Mr. Debasish B. Krishnatreya, Assistant Program Officer of NSS Unit. ## Soil analysis based on complexometric titration

A soil analysis based on complexometric titration was performed from 17<sup>th</sup> February -22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2022 by the Department of Chemistry in order to estimate the amount of macro nutrients such as Calcium and Magnesium in soil samples of Suren Das College, Hajo. 
### **1) Extempore speech competition in connection with World Environment Day:**


### **2) Street Play on Conservation of Environment:**






Figure: Vermicomposting Unit
