Guiding Principles

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) prepares strategy and planning on various aspects in line with the Vision and Mission Statements of the College, and also in order to fine-tune the academic and administrative requirements of the College. The Co-ordinator, IQAC places the policy making proposals in the IQAC core committee meetings, resolutions adopted and the same are forwarded to the College Authority for discussion and appropriate resolutions in the Governing Body. As per direction of the College Governing Body (G.B.), the Principal/Secretary of the College implements and executes them through a process of decentralization of works. While planning the policy of the college especial emphasis is put on executing the recommendations of the NAAC Peer Team Visit of the last Cycle. The College was assessed for the Second Cycle in the month of April, 2015 by the NAAC Peer Team and five recommendations were received vide its Report. The present Perspective Plan has been prepared for a period of five years, from July 2016- June 2021 so as to set up quality benchmarks in Academic as well as Administrative matters.

Objectives of the Perspective Plan
